The Message (Mission Statement)

Committed to the global furtherance of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the kingdom of God, and the soon coming King of Kings (Mark 16:15; John 14:6; Acts 4 :12; Acts 1:11; Revelations 5:6)

The Messengers (Objectives)

The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists is not a legislative organ to any national entity, but it is rather a coalition of Christians and Christian organizations having the commitment for the global furtherance of the Gospel and the kingdom of God as service agents:

1. To uphold one another in prayer.
2. To support and encourage one another in the task of missions and evangelism.
3. To promote Christian fellowship and cooperation among worshippers of God throughout the world.
4. To provide means of consultation and cooperation among the members and related agencies.
5. To share mutual concerns and insights relating to any crucial, spiritual and temporal issues of the Christendom.
6. To administer relief in times of crises.
7. To promote exchange of personnel among member Christian organizations and Churches, in special areas of ministry.
8. To disseminate helpful information and up-to-date statistics for the benefit of the Network.
9. To be a voice to the world and governments in defense of the faith, social justice, and persecuted believers, as the largest network of global evangelists in the society of Christ.

MEMBERSHIP AND RESPONSIBILITY

Individual Membership

Membership is open to all believers of the Lord Jesus Christ, and for all others seeking or desiring to accept the Lord Jesus Christ as their Lord and personal savior and master over their lives and serve as a service agent for the Lord Jesus Christ.

Group Membership

Any Christian council or Christ-centered fraternal organization which is committed to the global furtherance of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the kingdom of God, and desires to be endorsed as a service agent of The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists is eligible to apply for Group membership, subject to the approval of the Executive Council.

Responsibilities

1. In accepting membership in The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists, each member, or group/leader thereby accepts responsibility for assisting in the furtherance of the purpose and work of the Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists.
2. The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists has no authority to exercise control or governance over any of the activities or programs of any member.

STRUCTURE

1. The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists is a unit of The Samaritan Woman Global Evangelistic Ministries (USA) and St. Christy University of Theology & Seminary, all located in the United States of America (USA).
2. All activities and programs of the Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists is strictly directed by the delegated leaders of The Samaritan Woman Global Evangelistic Ministries (USA) and St. Christy University of Theology & Seminary (USA). The delegated leaders shall constitute the Global Executive Council.
3. The Global Executive Council of the Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists shall consist of regional representatives (referred to as Regional Ambassadors) appointed by The Samaritan Woman Global Evangelistic Ministries (USA) and St. Christy University of Theology & Seminary (USA).
4. Regional Ambassadors of the Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists shall direct all activities and programs of this network at the regional level under the direct supervision of the Global Executive Council.
5. District Representatives shall be appointed by the Regional Ambassadors, with approval from the Global Executive Council. The district representatives shall be referred to as District Ambassadors. The District Ambassadors shall in consultation with the Regional Ambassadors, develop and direct programs and activities in the nations or country they represent.
6. Resident Ambassadors shall be nominated by the District Ambassadors and appointed by the Regional Ambassadors as established by the Regional Ambassador.
7. Coordinators shall be nominated by the Resident Ambassadors to assist in the functions and duties of the Resident Ambassadors. District Ambassadors shall appoint Coordinators. There shall be Zonal and Area Coordinators respectively.

MEETINGS

Global Conferences

1. The Global Executive Council shall organize and convene Global Conferences and Global Events for the Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists, at locations and dates as shall be established by the Global Executive Council.
2. All members or groups of members of The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists who shall be in good standing in the network shall be eligible to participate in all Global Conferences and Global Events.
3. The Regional Ambassadors shall be responsible for coordinating all Global Conferences and Global Events under the direction of the Global Executive Council.
4. District Ambassadors shall be responsible for assisting Regional Ambassadors in coordinating Global Conferences and Global Events.

Regional Conferences

1. Regional Ambassadors, shall in consultation with the Global Executive Council, organize and convene Regional Conferences and Regional Events in the Regions they represent. All Regional Conferences and Regional Events shall have prior approval from the Global Executive Council.
2. All members or groups of members of The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists who shall be in good standing in the network shall be eligible to participate in all Regional Conferences and Regional Events.
3. District Ambassadors in host countries shall be responsible for coordinating all Regional Conferences and Regional Events under the direction of the Regional Ambassador.
4. Resident Ambassadors in host countries shall be responsible for assisting District Ambassadors in coordinating Regional Conferences and Regional Events.

District Conferences

1. District Ambassadors, shall in consultation with the Regional Ambassador, organize and convene District Conferences and District Events in the Districts they represent. All District Conferences and District Events shall have prior approval from the Regional Ambassador.

2. All members or groups of members of The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists who shall be in good standing in the network shall be eligible to participate in all District Conferences and District Events.
3. Resident Ambassadors in host countries shall be responsible for coordinating all District Conferences and District Events under the direction of the District Ambassador.
4. Coordinators in host countries shall be responsible for assisting Resident Ambassadors in coordinating District Conferences and District Events.

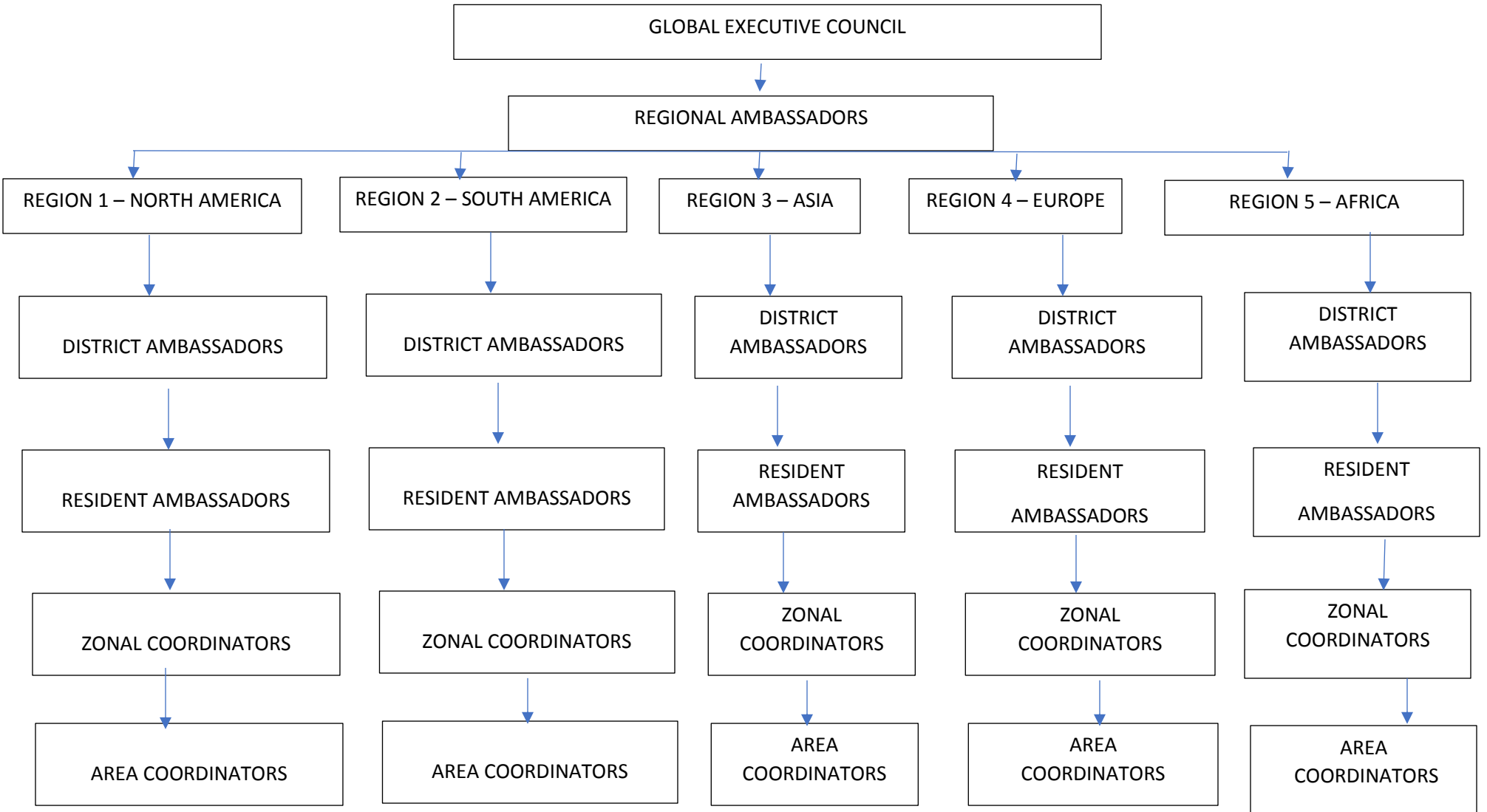
National Conferences

1. Resident Ambassadors, shall in consultation with the District Ambassador, organize and convene National Conferences and National Events in the Country they represent. All National Conferences and National Events shall have prior approval from the District Ambassador.
2. All members or groups of members of The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists who shall be in good standing in the network shall be eligible to participate in all National Conferences and National Events.
3. Coordinators in each country shall be responsible for coordinating all National Conferences and National Events under the direction of the Resident Ambassador.

Zonal Conferences

1. Zonal Coordinators, shall in consultation with the Resident Ambassador, organize and convene Zonal Conferences and Zonal Events in the Zones they represent. All Zonal Conferences and Zonal Events shall have prior approval from the Resident Ambassador.
2. All members or groups of members of The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists who shall be in good standing in the network shall be eligible to participate in all Zonal Conferences and Zonal Events.
3. Area Coordinators in each zone shall be responsible for coordinating all zonal Conferences and zonal Events under the direction of the Resident Ambassador.

FINANCE

1. The source of income for the Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists shall be a contribution by each member within the network, proceeds from events and conferences, freewill offerings and voluntary gifts.
2. A proposed budget and financial report shall be submitted to leadership at various levels for approval.
3. The Ambassadors at various levels shall have oversight of the financial accounting and reporting of the Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists, and all relevant books and records shall be properly kept at the office of the Chairperson.

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

1. Any individual who is a believer of the Lord Jesus Christ, or desire to accept the Lord Jesus Christ as their Lord and personal savior and master over their lives and serve as a service agent for the Lord Jesus Christ, seeking to become a member of The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists shall complete and submit a membership application form to the office of the Regional Ambassador for approval.
2. Any Christian council or Christ-centered fraternal organization which is committed to the global furtherance of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the kingdom of God, and desires to be endorsed as a service agent of The Strategic Religious Network of Global Evangelists, shall complete and submit a membership application form to the office of the Regional Ambassador for approval.
3. The Regional Ambassador shall act upon all membership applications and forwarded list of approved members to the Global Executive Council for issuance of welcome aboard membership package.

III. *Event Name*

SPIRITUAL BATTLEFIELD READINESS PRAYER CONFERENCE

Event Description

Developed under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, Spiritual Battle Field Readiness applies bible-based military combat principles, which is deemed extremely important for our Christian survival as servants and children of God. The facilitator, Reverend Dr. E.K. Ogoe-Anderson received insightful understanding of the theological teachings of Apostle Paul to the early Christendom on the broader themes of spiritual agility requirements and its essentials for overcoming spiritual combats against the church and the saints.

Thus, through the saints at Ephesus, Apostle Paul reveals the importance of Spiritual Battle Readiness and the need to not engage in any spiritual warfare/ battle unprepared "put on the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand (Ephesians 6:11-18 King James Version (KJV)).

Furthermore, through the saints in Corinth, Apostle Paul again unravels the importance of developing a combat mind-set which is extremely essential for combat survival "for though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds; Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ (2 Corinthians 10:3-5 King James Version (KJV)).

Ultimately, the Lord Jesus Christ himself places so much emphasis on the need for a Christian Minister to be battle ready for the great commission:

" Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first binds the strong man? and then he will spoil his house"
(Matthew 12:29 King James Version (KJV))

The Lord challenges the unprepared Minister for battle if there could be any victory without preparing for the battle ahead: "Can the prey be taken from the mighty man, Or the captives of a tyrant be rescued?" (Isaiah 49:24 King James Version (KJV)).

Guarded by his personal military service training and law enforcement training experiences, and numerous interactions with military veterans, and extensive research on combat readiness and warfare, Spiritual Battlefield Readiness unravels uncommon principles for success in spiritual warfare.
